Buses were a Transport For London success story between 2000 & 2014. Patronage climbed by 69%, fuelled by a stable, reliable network & service improvements.

In 2015/6 there was a turnaround. Passenger journeys dropped by 71m (3%), with just a small increase in the preceding year.

Waltham Forest routes: 58, 69, 212 & 257 lost passengers in both years, showing a far greater decline than the London average. Reduced fares' income makes the services less viable and possible targets for future cuts.
