

Better Access By Bus

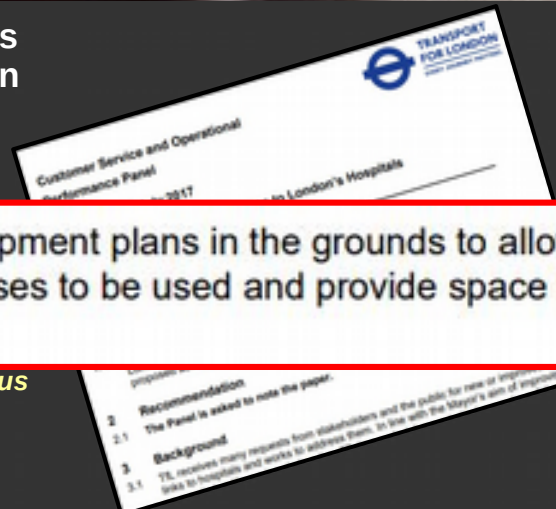


London's Mayor, Sadiq Khan aims to improve access to health services. Whipps Cross Hospital features in a London-wide review of bus links.

The Capital's transport chiefs have come up with plans to improve bus journeys to local hospitals. A scheme to get more buses, including double-deckers, into the grounds of Whipps Cross Hospital is on the cards.

Save Our Buses (SOB) backs TfL's plans which could:

- Boost access for patients, visitors and hospital staff.
- Take passengers on routes 56 and 357 into the hospital grounds rather than terminating at Whipps Cross Roundabout.
- Run the 257 bus through the hospital grounds, supporting routes W12, W15 & W19.
- Encourage more people to use public transport, cutting congestion & pollution.

This will be subject to feasibility and cost considerations.

Ditching plans for Waltham Forest Council's Mini-Holland bus hub on the edge of Epping Forest could provide the necessary funding.
