W12 - Planned Schedule

Monday to Saturday daytime: - Every 20 minutes

Evening and Sunday:- Every 30 minutes

Troubled Times

Unexpected delays knock most bus routes off schedule from time to time. On a low frequency route, such as the W12, the service can fall apart as Save Our Buses discovered on Friday 9th September.

SOB observed W12 buses towards Wanstead at the Grosvenor Park Road stop on Hoe St.

Four buses departed within 15 minutes at the times below:

1. Whipps Cross 6.14pm

2. Whipps Cross 6.17pm

3. Wanstead 6.20pm

4. Wanstead 6.29pm

Journeys on the W12 should be evenly spaced, every 20 minutes.

Six vehicles run the W12 peak service.

Four buses close together left just two covering the rest of the route.



SOB's monitoring of the W12 indicates:

- o A badly disrupted service with buses bunched, unevenly spaced & long gaps.
- o Only 50% of journeys beyond Whipps Cross to Snaresbrook, South Woodford & Wanstead.
- W12 passengers waiting in Coppermill Lane, Walthamstow Village or Snaresbrook Road facing lengthy waits for their only bus.
