## Break The Cycle Of Decline

Less than 4.6 million passengers boarded W15 buses in the year to April 2017. That's down from over 6 million three years earlier.

Traffic delays caused by road closures and cycle works over several years have undermined the service resulting in:

- ◆ Slower buses and longer journey times.
- ◆ Journeys cut short, failing to reach the end of the route.
- ◆ Buses bunching together and long gaps in the service.

Dropping by almost a quarter, the loss of more than 1.4m passengers threatens the viability of the W15 route.

It also puts the failing policies of Transport For London and the London Borough Of Waltham Forest in the spotlight.
