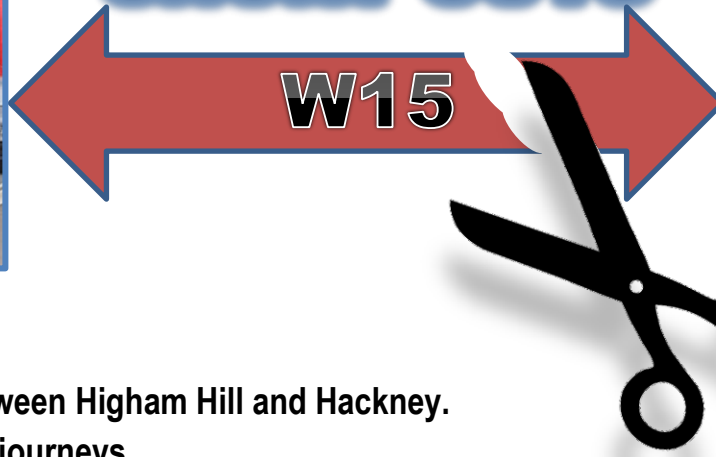

SHORT JOURNEYS

All W15 buses should run between Higham Hill and Hackney.

There are no scheduled short journeys.

Buses mainly run late due to traffic congestion.

Journeys are then cut short to plug gaps in the opposite direction.

More & more trips are being cut, resulting in many passengers **MISSING THE BUS.**



Save Our Buses checked out the W15 in Hoe Street, during the evening rush hour on Friday 27th May.

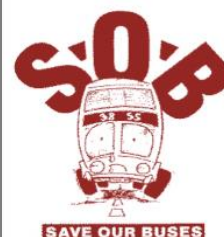
Many W15 buses were stopping short of their final destination
