Time For A Review

The sight of Hoe Street gridlocked should be a major cause for concern. With buses at a standstill, the workhorse of Waltham Forest's public transport is being systematically undermined.

Transport For London has tried to reduce the impact of delays but still the problems persist for the Borough's passengers. This has resulted in:

- ◆ Slower buses and increased journey times.
- ◆ Journeys cut short of their usual destination, forcing passengers to change buses or walk, if they are able to do so.
- ◆ Bunching of buses, running close together instead of being evenly spaced.
- ◆ Unreliability and large gaps between buses, even on busy routes.

Save Our Buses is calling on London's Mayor, Sadiq Khan, to commission an independent review into how the Mini-Holland scheme has affected Waltham Forest's bus services.
