

Mind The Gaps !

The W16 bus has unique links, providing the only service along Hainault Road and part of Wood Street. During May Transport For London cut the W16 frequency.

Reliability of buses, now scheduled every **13** minutes, is hit by traffic delays. This creates extended gaps in the service. Unlucky passengers are waiting longer at stops.

W16 PASSENGER INFORMATION:
- 3 buses in 9 minutes
but bigger gaps along
the route.
- Less buses to Leyton
& Leytonstone.
- Longer waits at stops.

Uneven spacing resulted in three buses appearing at the Bakers Arms in 9 minutes. That caused lengthy waits for passengers on other parts of the route. Gaps of about 30 minutes will have hit the W16.

Worse still, a journey terminated at the Bakers Arms, missing out Leyton & Leytonstone. That's less buses & longer gaps for passengers waiting for a return W16 at the busy Leytonstone Station stop.
