

# SHORT CUTS 2

## ACROSS WALTHAM FOREST



### Traffic Trouble

12 months of increasing traffic has hit Waltham Forest's bus services.  
Severe delays in Walthamstow affect journeys across the Borough.  
As reliability takes a hit, more trips on more routes get shortened.



### 97 Stratford City - Chingford Station

A Northbound 97 in Walthamstow Town Centre, short running to Chingford Mount.

This reduces the service to:

- Old Church Road
- The Ridgeway
- Chingford Green
- Chingford Station Road
- Chingford Station

SOB observed two additional short journeys to Chingford Mount in the space of an hour.

We have recently recorded numerous short trips to Walthamstow Crooked Billet, cutting even more links to the North of the Borough

### 97 Chingford Station - Stratford City

A Southbound 97 in Hoe Street, shortened to Leyton Green.

This cuts the service to:

- Leyton Town Centre
- Leyton Station
- Downsell Road
- Stratford City

### 230 Upper Walthamstow - Wood Green

This journey was curtailed to Tottenham Hale, breaking links in neighbouring Harringey to Turnpike Lane & Wood Green.

On 29-04-16 at 6.00pm in Hoe Street, SOB noted three 230 buses in a stationary queue. Each had **Tottenham Town Hall** as the destination.

### 230 Wood Green - Upper Walthamstow

This journey halted at Walthamstow Central, breaking links to:

- Leyton Bakers Arms
- Whipps Cross
- Wood Street
- Upper Walthamstow



### 357 Chingford Hatch – Whipps Cross

Bus cut to Walthamstow Central missing out Bakers Arms & Whipps Cross

### 357 Whipps Cross – Chingford Hatch

Bus cut to Walthamstow Central missing out Bell Corner, Crooked Billet, Chingford Mount & Chingford Hatch



## Short journeys are cuts to the bus service.

Route 357, shown above, is scheduled every 15 minutes at the busiest times. Missing part of the route leaves gaps of 30 minutes.

Occasional shortened journeys are unavoidable but they have increased in recent months. Reliability on Waltham Forest's most **accessible & inclusive** public transport is reduced.
